

Common Nouns and Proper Nouns

Common Nouns: A common noun is a 'common' name given to every person, place or thing of the same class or kind.

Example: books, animals, tree, mountain, museum, food.

Proper Nouns: A proper noun is the name of a **particular** person, place or thing.

Proper nouns always begin with capital letters.

Example: Tuesday, Japan, London, Sam, Earth, Amazon River.
