

Prepositions

A preposition is a word placed before a noun or a pronoun to show its relation to some other word.

***Example:* The book is on (*Preposition*) the table. The word on is indicating the position of the book.**

***Other examples are:* in, within, for, since, between, among, after, behind, beneath, inside.**
