

## **Singular and Plural Words**

When writing sentences which contain either singular or plural words, it is important to attach the correct form of the tense with it e.g. ‘They *was* frightened’. The correct sentence would be ‘they *were* frightened’.

- The reason (singular) are (*plural*) not justified. **Incorrect**

- The reason (singular) is (*singular*) not justified. **Correct**
