

Singulars and Plurals

- A noun that denotes **one person**, **place** and **thing** is said to be in the **singular** number.

- A noun that denotes **more persons**, **places** or **things** than one, is said to be in the **plural** numbers.

The plurals of nouns are formed in many different ways:

Example: knife – knives

child – children
