Singulars and Plurals

- A noun that denotes <u>one person</u>, <u>place</u> and <u>thing</u> is said to be in the <u>singular</u> number.
- A noun that denotes **more persons**, **places** or **things** than one, is said to be in the **plural** numbers.

The plurals of nouns are formed in many different ways:

Example: knife – kni<u>ves</u> child – child<u>ren</u>
